

Quality Compass (QC) Benchmark Level Breakouts

- NCQA national, regional and state benchmarks are based on different levels of reporting product type(s).
- NCQA requires a minimum of five health plan submissions to report benchmark results on a measure (e.g., if three plans from Alaska reported Breast Cancer Screening results, no benchmark would be calculated for Alaska Breast Cancer screening). However, the absence of a benchmark for one measure does not mean that an average does not exist for other measures, since plans may submit partial HEDIS results.
- The EPO reporting product was introduced in QC 2016. Due to the EPO and PPO results being trendable from year to year, this is a combined benchmark. There are no separate benchmark results for either reporting product.
